Task: Construction Work to Reduce Exposure

All participants should sign in the Acknowledgement section on the last page. **No Workers are to arrive on site if they have any symptoms-Fever, Cough, Shortness of Breath, Sore Throat-**

Basic Job Steps	Potential Hazards	Controls & Recommended Actions	Training Associated
1. Read and sign off Covid 19 Guidelines and Procedures for all Construction Sites and Workers	Untrained Workers	Provide workers copy of Guidelines. Guidelines posted	Sign off document
2. Self Certify Daily	Worker Exposure	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No signs of fever over 100.3 in last 24 hours • Have not had close contact with individual diagnosed with COVID 19 • Have not been asked to self isolate or quarantine by a doctor 	All workers to document on a daily basis
3. If working in enclosed building or confined space	Worker Exposure	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Medical Professional or Trained Individual to take temperatures of workers 	
4. Review Hand Wash stations	Workers do not clean hands	Posted Hand Wash Instructions at washing stations. Soap, hand sanitizer, towels and trash container in place.	

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5. Cleaning of all common surfaces	Areas not disinfected	Tool handles, door knobs hand rails, control buttons, equipment cabs, wash station areas, ladders or any other surface that could have any contract should be cleaned and cleaning schedule documented. All areas should be cleaned at least twice a day.	Documented cleaning log
6. Review SDS of cleaning products	Not Using Product Correctly or Using products that should not be used together	Use products as directed by SDS	
7. Wearing Personal Protective Equipment	Spread of an virus Cuts to hands Falling objects Foreign body in eye	Cut Resistant Gloves Dust mask to be worn if working within 6' of other workers. Or ½ piece respirator Hard hats to be worn Safety Glasses to be worn	PPE Tool box talk Appendix D for dust masks Fit test and medical evaluation for ½ piece respirator
8. Maintain social distancing	Spread of Virus	All workers to maintain at least 6' distance.	
9. Posting of Reminders		Posting of Special covid 19 Reminders of PPE Use, Social Distance, Washing of Hands, Cleaning of Tools and Equipment, Covid Guidelines	

If a worker does test as positive for Covid 19, site should be shut down, workers who may have been in contact with worker tested. All equipment to be professionally disinfected and follow all protocols as outlined by Federal and State Guidelines.
